

Database Overview...

The Partnering Database (Version 1.5) is currently responsible for tracking Partnering element ratings on SHA construction projects throughout the state. The system provides a web site for entering data into the Partnering database and allows users to compile and generate reports based on the rating element scores.

The current (hard copy) Partnering Project Rating Form has been modified and is due to be released in 2008. To facilitate the new changes in the project rating form, The State Highway Administration will be releasing version 2.0 of the Partnering database on **February 1, 2008**.

The new version will provide an updated user interface while incorporating the changes to the Partnering Rating form.

Changes in Version 2.0

The following section briefly outlines the changes to the Partnering Database in version 2.0.

- **Material Clearance**

In the previous version of the Partnering Database, Material Clearance was rated as an element on the evaluation form. This rating element has been dropped from the required evaluation elements and moved into a statistical data section. The data previously recorded for this element will still show up on reports however, it will not appear on the Partnering Rating Form.

- **Planning and Looking Ahead**

In version 2.0 a new rating element has been added to the evaluation form. The element is labeled "Planning / Looking Ahead". As with the other elements on the form you will need to provide a grade between 1 and 4 for this element.

- **Stakeholders**

The following additional Evaluator Types have been added to the database:

- County/City Government
- Community/Business Liaison
- Utilities

- **Statistical Data**

A Statistical Data section has been added to the application and database. This data will be provided by the Project Engineer/Superintendent for each evaluation period. A new link will be provided in the website menu to provide access to the Statistical Data section.

The following elements are tracked in the Statistical Data section:

- **Safety**

(Number of Incidents/Accidents to Personnel)

- **Material Clearance**

(% provided by OMT)

- **MOT Rating**

(Average for this period, using Form #52.4.01)

- **E/S Rating**

(Average for this period, using Form #OOC61)

- **Evaluation Summary Reports**

The Evaluation Summary report incorporates the new statistical data in a section above the rating element averages
